The Media has highlighted the changes which are impacting on Government Schools in WA for 2014 and beyond. These funding changes will affect Mt Lawley SHS and the Executive Team and Leadership Team are planning through the implementation of potential cuts for next year. The wider community will be notified of the impact of changes about the school as they become evident. The quality of the educational program at the school will not be compromised as I believe we have a very good program which needs supporting and sustaining.

Highlighting the successes of our school is the outstanding performances of the Year 10 Mock Trials Team. They competed in the Supreme Court on Tuesday evening to win through to the State Final of the competition. They are the most successful Year 10 Team already in the history of the competition and now are in the Final which exceeds all expectations as they are competing against Senior Students from other schools. Well done to Ms Siobhan Galavan and the Year 10 students.

Our Music and Drama Departments have had a string of performance of late and all have been of a very high calibre. Tonight we have the final Senior and Junior concerts for the year and I anticipate the standard of performance to be very high as gauged by the performances we have seen thus far this year. The Year 12 students go to their final school exams in just under two weeks and I am seeing the signs of hard work and stress from most of our Year 12 cohort. They all need to be very switched on and focused at this time if they are to produce the results they warrant. Solid attendance at school and commitment to completing all assessment items to the best of their ability is essential.

Our Year 10 and 11 students will be completing their 2013 curriculum studies in the first three to four weeks of term 4 and then rolling into their curriculum programs which continue into 2014. Likewise this is a pressured time for these students and the school would appreciate parent support and contact with any concerns regarding student progress with their school work.

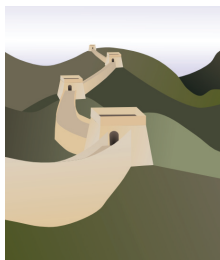
