- 2008 Timetable and Student numbers: Year 8 in-take near maximum with only 11 "out of boundary" offers after catering for "in boundary", "siblings", "SVAPA" and "LOTE". Year 12 numbers will increase from 220 to 280. This is a school in demand.
- Arts Productions: special mention of recent Music Concert and Music, and Year 12, Showcases. High quality and successful productions are a credit to the students and staff.
