Funds raised were used in many different ways by the teachers within these areas. The Health Committee again offered a great support with the organisation of the Middle School Health Expo "Get Real", the Healthy Active Breakfast and also Year 12 "Chill out". Hopefully in 2011 we will be able to offer the same support to these areas. Sadly, we have had to say "Goodbye" to some of our long standing and most enthusiastic volunteers as their children have now finished Year 12; David Hawkes was officially farewelled at the volunteer morning tea in December and Julie Kernutt has graduated Mount Lawley after many years of dedicated service. It has truly been a pleasure to work alongside these parents as a part of Mount Lawley P&C. My thanks to everyone who has helped throughout 2010.

Parent donations via the school voluntary contributions were excellent in 2010 and this money has been put to various programs around the school. Year 12 Chill Out was entirely funded by the P&C this year as Healthways funding has ceased and the purchase of TShirts for the Language students was supported by the P&C. An interactive whiteboard was installed in the Library and we took delivery of outdoor seating for students. Book trolleys were purchased for Middle School, MP3 players for Languages, money has been set aside to improve security for bags at the school gym and the P&C will fund the Homework Club to be run after school during 2011. The P&C funded the new school website which, after a very lengthy wait, is now up and running and improving with it's supply of information and use of email group lists.

The Uniform Shop is now well established and Nell Gray are providing an excellent service, funds that the P&C had retained as a safety net have been made available for use by the school and staff have been asked to submit requests for funding. Some of the above projects were a part of this funding and more shall be spent in 2011. My hopes for 2011 are yet greater parent involvement and support for the school and our children. Hopefully we will see the building fund established and financing an airconditioning program for the school.
