It is proposed to run it for the whole day as a series of small concerts to accommodate the venue restrictions (stage and audience) of the Richard Gill Theatre at WAAPA. This format would require a significant commitment of MSC helpers. Michelle will request from Moya assistance from the Certificate Students. Additional attractions including a photo booth and Mothers Day gift basket were discussed. Michelle will discuss a photo booth with Amanda (who has agreed to stay on as photographer this year), and Stuart has offered to help with the booth if it goes ahead. Technical support for the concert is only lights.
- The Committee discussed the viability of setting up a fund for the proposed move into the WAAPA venues in several years' time. One potential expense would be \$100K of pianos. This kind of fund would require approval from the P&C to hold over funds. Further discussion will be required.
