General Business

- Meetings to be held at earlier time of 6.30pm from now on.

 (Year 7 Art Exhibition teachers, Year 8 MSND Production team and Year 9 Tiny Works teachers

- and mentors). Also, good for any quick communications regarding last minute changes to EMC's, reminders about rehearsals, question's about excursion pick up and drop off's etc.
- Parents have requested P&C meeting get Teams account so sub committees can offer hybrid meetings and internet access. Hopefully can trial next meeting.
- Parents have requested update on MLSHS acquiring WAAPA facilities. Last we heard, building 1 and 2 were to be acquired by MLSHS but building 3 not. Parents feel additional classrooms and larger canteen will be needed with future growth. When first announced PSG expressed concerns about funding larger program and whether ECU are spending funds on the ongoing maintenance of buildings that they are leaving. No information has been provided to PSG on the engagement surveys and feedback parents provided previously. No feedback from government on Mt Lawley community working groups. No staff or parents involved in working group to date.

Note, I checked after meeting and ECU annual report shows they've changed useful life of Mt Lawley Assets from 10 years to 5 years but does indicate ongoing maintenance at current campus has been carried out.
